# SCHOLARSHIP CRITERIA AND APPLICATION FORM for the Elmira-Corning Branch of the AAUW

The American Association of University Women was founded in 1882 for the purpose of "uniting of the alumnae of different institutions for practical educational work." In accordance with the goal of working for broader opportunities for women, the Elmira-Corning Branch of the Association offers annual scholarships of varying amounts to women pursuing an associate or bachelor's degree at an accredited college or university.

The Elmira-Corning branch of AAUW is proud to offer Return to Learning scholarships to mature women who are working toward an associate or bachelor's degree. Scholarship amounts are determined by the success of our fund-raising projects and have ranged from \$500 -\$2,000 in previous years. The Return to Learning Scholarship offers our moral and financial support to women who are well along in their studies in their quest to develop and improve their careers.

The Zelda Sadinsky Scholarship is a memorial to a branch member who let our support make a significant impact in her life. First awarded in 2005, this scholarship is supported with funds from the Sadinsky family and branch members.

The Polly Leveen Scholarship is a memorial to a branch member who was a very active in AAUW and passionate about the mission. First awarded in 2015, this scholarship is supported with funds from the Leveen family and branch members.

#### **GUIDELINES FOR APPLICANTS**

#### To be eligible an applicant must be:

- 1. At least 24 years of age and continuing their education after a significant interruption.
  - 2. Currently residing in the Twin Tiers.
- 3. Applicant must be registered in an undergraduate program for a new career or furthering an existing career. The course(s) must be taken at an accredited 2-year or 4-year college. No preference will be given to either full or part-time students.
- 4. Applicant must be currently enrolled in a minimum of six (6) credit hours at the undergraduate level in an accredited college.
- 5. Applicant must have plans to further their education at the next level if they are within one semester of graduation.

- 6. Applicant must explain her personal goals and commitment to her studies through the written application.
- 7. Applicant will include an essay: considerable weight will be given to the applicant's ability to convey creative ideas through a well-organized, clear, and thoughtful essay dealing with some aspect of her field of study. The essay must be typed, double-spaced, and include her name on each page. Preference is given to an essay that is written especially for this application rather than previously written class paper. The essay should demonstrate knowledge of the applicant's field of study and should blend personal insight with the discussion of how this study will achieve her long-term goals. It should also demonstrate a commitment to community service, academic/career goals; describe how applicant meets the above criteria, and how the scholarship will contribute to enabling her pursuit in a career.

  - 9. Interviews will be scheduled during the month of April.
  - 10. Award notification will be made by Friday May 20, 2022.
  - 11. Award Ceremony will be held at the AAUW's Annual Luncheon Thursday, June 2, 2022, at the Elmira Country Club.

Awards are based on financial need and projection of success in reaching the applicant's academic goal.
